



## 2025-2026 SAP Warning Statement

**Instructions:** Please read all of the information below carefully, then sign and date to indicate your understanding and acknowledgement.

Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to receive federal and/or state financial aid. Progress is measured qualitatively and quantitatively, with a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 and completion rate of 67% in all courses. The academic records of students are evaluated at the end of each semester, including summer. If the student falls below either standard at the end of a specific semester, they may be placed in the financial aid warning status.

By reading and signing this statement the student named above acknowledges they have fallen below the acceptable standards required for financial aid eligibility. The student is also requesting to be placed in the financial aid warning status which entitles them to financial aid for the specified semester. To be placed in the warning status, the student agrees to the following conditions:

- To complete all classes that he/she has registered for in the upcoming semester with a grade of 'C' or better, and understand that if any class is dropped before the financial aid census date then this contract is null and void and you will be responsible for your charges.
- Understanding that if the student does not meet both of the previous requirements, they will not be eligible for financial aid during their next term of enrollment.
- Understanding that this warning is for one semester only and that the student's academic status will be reevaluated at the end of the warning semester.

If the student is successful during the warning semester and brings their completion rate and grade point average up to acceptable standards, the student will no longer be required to be in the warning status. If the student is successful during the warning, but still falls below the acceptable standards, they will meet with the Financial Aid Director to determine what is required for continued financial aid eligibility. If the student does not complete all classes attempted with a grade of 'C' or better, the student's financial aid eligibility will be **suspended**. The student would then be required to complete the financial aid appeal process if they wished to be considered for financial aid funds in the future.
