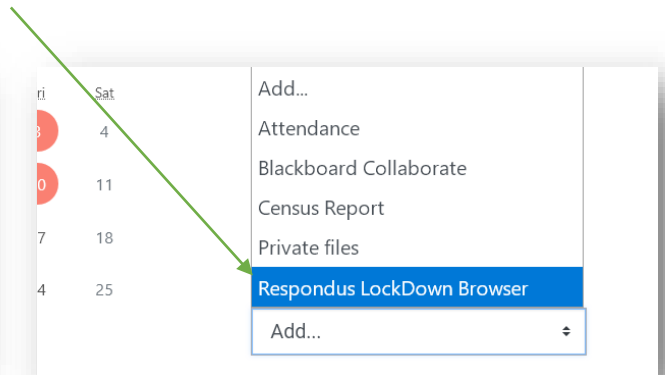
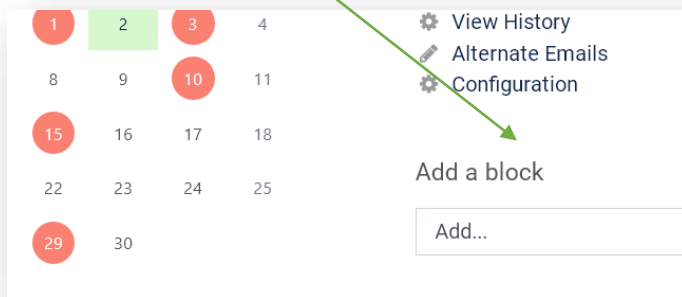
1. In your course, select **Course Dashboard**



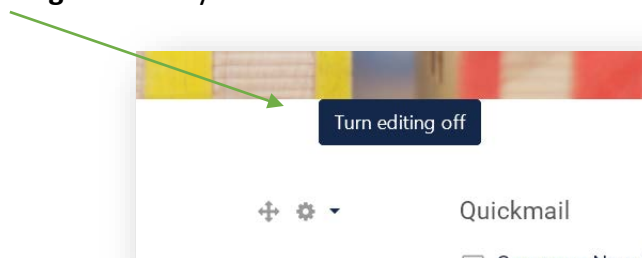
2. Click on **Edit blocks**



3. Under **Add a block**, select **Respondus LockDown Browser**

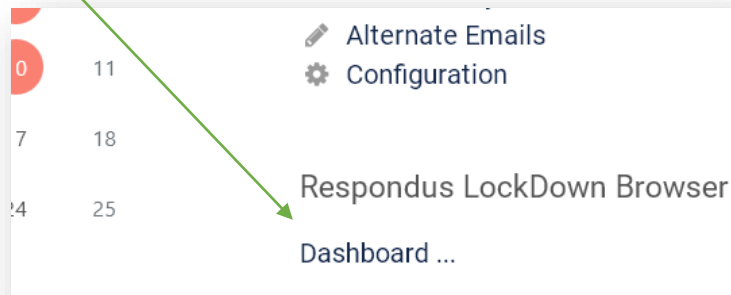


4. Make sure to **Turn editing off** when you are finished




