

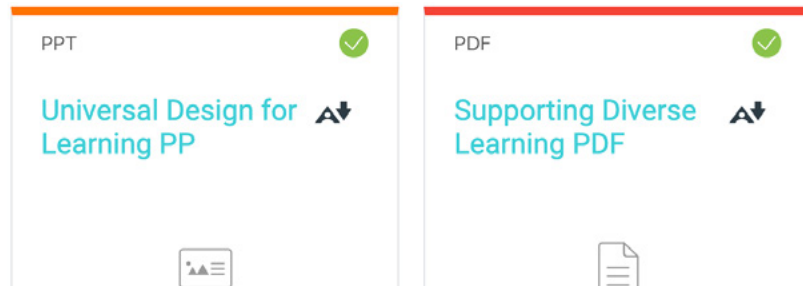
Alternative Formats

Find file formats that support your learning

How do you prefer to engage with digital learning content? Do you read on your phone or tablet, use a screen reader, like to annotate and highlight, or listen to an audio version? Ally automatically generates “Alternative formats” from your original course files, and makes them available for download so that you can engage with course content in a way that works best for you.

Find Ally’s “Alternative formats” where you access your course content.

Select the grey arrow icon next to the content items or attached files in your course, and select the “Alternative formats” option from the drop down.



Know your options. Choose a format that’s right for you.

Tagged PDF Structured PDF for assistive technology	Improved structure for navigation Essential for screen readers
HTML For browser and mobile	Customize your text Adapts text to mobile screen sizes
ePub Reading on tablets and e-book readers	eBooks on tablets Annotating and highlighting
Electronic braille BRF version for electronic braille displays	Read more quickly Essential for visual impairments
Audio MP3 recording of text	Listen and learn on the go Engage different modalities
Translated version (opt-in format) A machine translated version of the doc	Experience a different language Access 50 different translations
