Campus security services and procedures are discussed during new student orientations, which are provided several times a year and are open to all members of the MTCC community and in ACA 111 (College Student Success) classes which are offered each semester. Members of the Campus Security Office conduct crime prevention presentations when requested by various community groups, including students and employees of MTCC. Security awareness programs encourage members of the campus community to be responsible for their own security and the security of others. Crime prevention tips and statistics on crime at MTCC are also included. Programs and information offered include general crime prevention forums and programs with discussions on topics such as alcohol abuse, domestic violence, self defense, fire safety, sexual assault prevention, and theft prevention.
