

Statement of Financial Aid Warning

Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to receive federal/state financial aid. This progress is measured qualitatively and quantitatively with an overall grade point of 2.0 and completion rate of all classes attempted of 67%. The academic records of students are evaluated at the end of each semester, including Summer. If the student falls below either standard at the end of a specific semester, he/she may be placed in the financial aid warning status.

By reading and signing this statement, the student acknowledges that he/she has fallen below the acceptable standards required for financial aid eligibility. The student is also requesting to be placed in the financial aid warning status which entitles him/her to financial aid for the specified semester. To be placed in the warning status, the student agrees to the following conditions:

- To complete all classes that he/she has registered for in the upcoming semester with a grade of "C" or better, and understand that if any class is dropped before the financial aid census date then this contract is null and void and you will be responsible for your charges.
- Understanding that if the student does not meet both of the previous requirements, he/she will not be eligible for financial aid
- Understanding that this warning is for one semester only and the student's academic status will be reevaluated at the end of the warning semester

If the student is successful during the warning semester and brings their completion rate and grade point average up to acceptable standards, the student will no longer be required to be in warning status. If the student is successful during the warning semester but still falls below the acceptable standards, he/she will meet with the Financial Aid Director to determine what is required for continued financial aid eligibility. If the student does not complete all classes attempted with a grade of "C" or better, the student's financial aid eligibility will be suspended. The student would then be required to complete the financial aid appeal process if he/she wishes to be considered for financial aid funds in the future.
