CHANGES TO THE FAFSA



The FAFSA, which has been available on October 1 in previous years, will be available **December 31, 2023**



Parents & Spouses whose income information is reported on your FAFSA are now called **Contributors**, and must all have an **FSA ID to provide consent**



The new scale used to evaluate your need for financial aid will be called the Student Aid Index (SAI), a number starting at -\$1,500 and on up

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The new simplified FAFSA will provide expanded eligibility for federal financial aid and remove barriers for certain student populations to be able to apply & qualify.

OTHER NEW INFORMATION

FAMILY SIZE Family size will be determined by the number of exemptions on your tax return, with the option to correct if it does not reflect your family's current size **Number of people in college** will no longer

size. **Number of people in college** will no longer be considered in your eligibility for aid.

FSA ID

All contributors (parents, step-parents, spouses) will be required to have an FSA ID to provide consent for Federal Tax Information (FTI) to be populated on your FAFSA. This also includes contributors who do not have a Social Security Number.

INVITING CONTRIBUTORS

You will need to invite all other contributors (parents, step-parents, spouses) to consent to FTI on your FAFSA via email.


START NOW!

Use the graphic below to determine who contributors for your FAFSA may be, and make sure you and all contributors have a **valid email address** and **know the log in information** to these accounts

If you do not already have an FSA ID, create one now at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>. Have all potential contributors create an FSA ID ahead of time as well.

Make sure you **save your login information** in a secure place, as you will use this year after year and **cannot create a new FSA ID!**



Locate and bring **2022 tax information** for you and all contributors when you complete the FAFSA

This includes tax returns, W2s/1099s, and any other records of money earned. If applicable, you should also bring records of investments, and records of untaxed income

Call 1-800-433-3243 if you or a

are having trouble logging in. Do this

ahead of time to recover your account, as there could be a waiting period!

"Parents" includes your biological or adoptive parents. If your parents are separated or divorced, your parent who **provides the most financial support** will be a contributor (and their spouse, if they have remarried)
